Ash Trees

We received questions from Homeowners regarding the status of our Ash Trees. The report given to the Landscape Director by the Arborist suggested discontinuing the treatment as it has proved ineffective in the past. The cost of treatment is around \$6000 every 2 years. This money will be used to replace the Ash Trees with Birch and Maple, the number of remaining trees to be replaced is unknown at this time.
