#### **Outside Faucets**

There seems to be confusion about the outside faucets and turning them off for the winter. One of the big advantages of these faucets is that all you need to do is turn them off at the outside faucet and leave everything else alone. They are designed to self-drain to the point that they will not freeze. You do not have to climb around in your laundry room to turn off the inside control for your unit. If you have access to your buildings water control, you definitely don't have to turn that one off.

f you choose to turn either of these inside controls off and on, it is totally your responsibility. Both for your safety in doing so and for the outside faucet. It is not the Associations responsibility for your safety or the condition of the valve or for turning it on or off.

The Association has supplied you with a very convenient and safe way to handle your outside water and hope you will take advantage of the safety and convenience it offers.
